Twenty-seven charter members met at the home of Robert and Juanita Weyler on Marshall Ave. in Clarksville on Sept. 12, 1948, to constitute the "First Missionary Baptist Church," as it was then called. Since that time God has used our church to reach many people for Christ, sponsor eleven missions, impact our local community with the gospel by witnessing and serving, take the gospel to various places in the world through active missions involvement and partnership, support our SBC missions ministries through giving and prayer, and in many other ways. Seven of the sponsored missions continue as churches today, and one, Primera Iglesia Bautista Hispana, continues as a partner mission to the community.


