# Pastor's Paragraphs

Easter is coming up on our calendars. Easter celebrates the eternity changing event, the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the grave. We celebrate the resurrection of Christ every Sunday we meet on the first day of the week, like the group of disciples who went to the empty tomb on that first Easter Sunday morning. It is good, however, for us to take one Sunday out of the year to celebrate on this great event. Our faith is established, not on a philosophy of life or religious principles, but on historical events, and the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the grave is the crowning event that changes everything.

The Bible says, "But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen. And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty ... For if the dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen. And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins! Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished ... But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep" (1 Cor. 15:13-20). We also read this: "Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead" (Rom. 1:3, 4).

Our Easter celebration will include our **Good Friday service**, our **Children's Easter Saturday** the following morning, and, of course, our **Easter Sunday services**. Pray for these services, plan now to come, and invite a friend or two.
