A Word from Nick

Greetings,

"Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night." (Psalm 1:1-2)

Instead of delighting in mocking and scoffing God with a lifestyle of sin and wickedness, this blessed man continually delights in God's instruction for his life. This "delighting" is taking pleasure in all that makes the God happy.

The key to delighting in God's Word is the spiritual discipline of continual meditation. Many times we think of this word negatively as something belonging to some New Age idea of trying to get in touch with the supernatural around us. But in this passage, meditate literally means "to murmur or mutter." This muttering occurs over and over again all throughout the day. In the book *Spiritual Disciplines for the Christian Life*, the author Donald Whitney states that meditation is, "deep thinking on the truths and spiritual realities revealed in Scripture for the purposes of understanding, application, and prayer" (48).

This meditation happens "day and night." It is a continual activity, which begs the question, "Where does your brain go when it's in neutral?" Does it go back to the counsel of the wicked, or does it seek the counsel of God?
