As you read this, your mission team is serving in Landa de Matamores, Mexico. We arrived in Landa on November 25, and, Lord willing, we will be returning to Indiana on December 2. Landa is a city in the Baijo region. It is estimated that there is less than a 2% Evangelical Christian presence in this region. To the best of our knowledge, our team is the first mission team from America to go to Landa. God has opened a great opportunity for us, but with it comes some difficult challenges. We are grateful for your prayers and support. We ask that you continue to pray that God will move and transform people's lives in an incredible way through our work in Mexico. Without God acting, we labor in vain. It is in complete reliance on Him that we seek to accomplish anything through this trip.

There are many objectives that we are striving to reach through our work in Mexico. However, there is one overarching goal of this trip; namely, to magnify our God, and Jesus Christ, His Son. To this end we strive with our brothers and sisters in Mexico, until one day when we join with them and a people "from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, ... crying out with a loud voice, 'Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!""
