Pastor's Paragraphs

What can I do to make a difference? We are part of a church that has adopted a challenging and biblical vision: *"Glorifying God by making and maturing disciples of Jesus Christ in Southern Indiana and around the world."* (See Matt. 28:18-20 for details). What can I do as an individual to be a part of fulfilling this vision? There are at least three things you can do.

First: *Live the Gospel*. I once had the remarkable privilege of having a personal conversation with the famous Baptist pastor, Dr. R. G. Lee. He told me and the young preachers with me that if we were going to preach the gospel, we must live it. "You can't play Beethoven on a wooden whistle," were his colorful words describing this. Paul admonished, "Work out your own salvation ... for it is God that works in you ..." (Phil. 2:12, 13).

Second: *Love others in Jesus' name*. "By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples," Jesus taught, "If ye have love one to another" (John 13:34). "Love your neighbor as yourself," is the second greatest commandment, second only to loving God. The whole message and ministry of Jesus Christ is grounded in the love of God for us (John 3:16). Apart from fulfilling any "vision" we may have adopted, we are to be people who embody and communicate the love of God to this world. We love because He loved (and loves).

Last, but not least: *Tell the story*. The gospel is the power of God unto salvation (Rom. 1:16), and giving the message of God's saving grace in Christ's death, burial, resurrection, and soon coming is what God uses to bring people to him (Rom. 10:17). Our great evangelistic task is, therefore, to get the gospel message to as many people as we can, however we may do so. Let's never forget that. We have the soul-saving gospel. Let's tell it. See you Sunday, **Bro: Russ**
