A Word from Nick.

Greetings,

"If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit." (Galatians 5:25)

Have you ever played the game Follow the Leader? It's the game where you mimic everything that the person at the front of the line does exactly like they do. I remember playing this game on a trampoline with some friends when I was younger. We would try to copy all of the different tricks that the first person did without falling or messing up. But depending on who the leader was, it felt almost impossible to follow after them

In Galatians 5, we see this kind of idea described whenever it says, "walk by the Spirit." Literally, this could be translated as "walk in line behind the leader." So the way we seek to follow after God is simply following after his Spirit.

You might ask, "How do I follow after Spirit?" First, it requires making decisions and choices according to the Holy Spirit's guidance in your life. And secondly, it requires us to act with the spiritual power that the Spirit of God supplies to every believer. Isn't it amazing that God equips us with what we need in order to follow after Him? In God's power and strength, we are able to abstain from the desires and works of the flesh and pursue after the desires of the Spirit of God.

The life we now live is not our own. We don't make the rules, we don't call the shots. Don't deceive yourself into thinking that you are in control of your life. Don't follow after your own heart. Instead, why don't you try following the true leader.
