Pastor's Paragraphs

When King Hezekiah sent to the prophet Isaiah asking him to pray for the city of Jerusalem, which was under siege by their enemies the Assyrians, Isaiah sent word back to the king: "Thus says the LORD: 'Do not be afraid of the words which you have heard, with which the servants of the king of Assyria have blasphemed Me. Surely I will send a spirit upon him, and he shall hear a rumor and return to his own land; and I will cause him to fall by the sword in his own land.""

We are not told how God revealed this word to Isaiah, but we do know it was certain and sure. This was a major message to a king of a nation in a time of military conflict. This was no time for stuttering or stammering or highsounding platitudes or religious fluff. It was time for clarity and certainty. I am intrigued by the question, "How did Isaiah have such certainty about such an outcome? How did he know this?" And, more to the point, "Can we ever have such certainty about God's will and God's plans for us?"

As I thought about this, I was led to 2 Tim. 3:16: "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." The times in which we live are not times for stuttering, stammering, or uncertainty about what God says or wills. And he has given us a certain and clear word. He has spoken to us through the Bible, through which he has also provided everything we need to be "thoroughly equipped for every good work," (v. 17). Just as certain as the word God gave to Hezekiah through the prophet Isaiah is the word God has given us in the Bible. Read it, study it, memorize it, obey it, and let it be your meditation day and night. As a result, your life will be like a "tree planted by the rivers of water," fruitful, enduring, and strong.
