I am also glad that our church family adopted the 2000 Baptist Faith and Message Statement at our last business meeting. Statements of faith, as the preamble to the BFM states, have been used historically to seek to present what a given group of believers believes regarding important issues and doctrines that are relevant to the day. They are also used as teaching aids to help us understand the faith "once delivered unto the saints." Our previous statement was developed in the early 1960's. Obviously, there are issues today that challenge Bible-believing Christians to articulate the Bible's message to our generation that were not considered at all in that by-gone era. Copies of the 2000 BFM statement are available free for you to take at the welcome center and at the church office. The Bible does not change. The message of the Bible is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Statements of faith like the BFM, however, are helpful tools to present to the current generation certain truths important to the age and to present our basic understanding of key doctrines of scripture. Adopting the 2000 BFM is a very helpful step as we witness to the truth in this generation.


