Go on a mission trip to Mexico that is sponsored by our church or somewhere else that will get you out of your comfort zone and expose vou to the world.

If you will commit to these five things for one year, your life will radically change. This is one part of a fantastic book that you should read if you have not already. Let's not settle for lukewarm Christianity. Instead, let us follow after Christ with radical faith.
