# Pastor's Paragraphs

Do you remember the account in Mattew 14 about Peter walking on the water? It is an amazing event, filled with truth for us. The disciples were in a boat on the stormy sea when Jesus approached them, walking on the water. At first they were full of fear at the sight (of course!) and unsure of what to make of this bizarre scene. Amazingly, after Jesus reassured them by identifying himself, the impulsive Peter asked Jesus to let him come to him in the same manner, walking on the water. Jesus answered, "Come." Can you imagine the exhilaration Peter experienced? Here he was, walking on the water, just like Jesus had done! But then, it all suddenly changed. The impossibility of what was happening set in on his mind and quenched his faith. Seeing the raging wind, he became afraid and cried, "Lord, save me!"

"Immediately Jesus stretched out his hand and caught him, and said to him, 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?""

Jesus word, "Come," inspired faith in Peter: his hand rescued him when Peter's faith failed.

We live by the word of God. He instructs us to walk by faith and rest in him and sometimes do what seems impossible. Sometimes – and it is awfully easy to do – we allow his word to us to fade away in the sight of the overwhelming challenges or trials that surround us. His hand is there to rescue us, yes, but we are people of His word. When storms of life arise, we can have victory by heeding his word. Keep your eyes on Christ and have victory. Don't let the waves drown your faith.
