Pastor's Paragraphs

I wish my church family could have known the man that was my pastor during my college days, which were the first days of my Christian life. Bro. Richard Oldham was recently called home after a lifetime of ministry, 57 years of it as pastor of the Glendale Baptist Church in Bowling Green, KY. I had just been saved as a 19-year-old college student when I gravitated toward Glendale Church. Looking at it from the outside, someone would have said that Bro. Richard, "took me under his wing." In reality what he did was disciple me and mentor me. I never heard him use that word, "disciple," as a verb. I never heard him use the word, "mentor." He didn't talk about these things; he didn't write books, articles, or blog posts about them; he just did them. He did it not only with me but with hundreds of other young people that came under his influence. I will ever be indebted to him for the way he poured his life into mine. Hardly a week goes by that I do not recall something that he taught me. Either by direct words to me, by the life he lived before me, or through the countless sermons I heard him preach, he taught me what it was to be a Christian and a minister. (I must say that I haven't arrived; I'm still on a journey to fully learn and apply these things in my life!) He taught me to believe the Bible. We memorized scripture together, discussed it, praved over it, and sought to obey it. He taught me to pray and to live with conviction as an ambassador for Christ. He taught me to win souls to Christ and to rely on the ministry of the Holy Spirit in our life and ministry. Through his example he taught me what it is to love others. He loved everybody: godly saints, wretched rebel sinners – he genuinely loved them and they knew it. This was the spirit of Christ in him. He taught me to love and serve the local church. He taught me the power and priority of the preaching of the word of God. Continuing to be the pastor of the church until his last day, he taught me not to quit. At his funeral, Pastor Lonnie Mattingly put it well when he reflected on Bro. Richard's wish that his life and ministry would both end on the same day. His earthly life ended, noted Bro. Lonnie, but his ministry lives on. Every time I saw him, he would comment on this article in the "Communicator." I always knew I had at least one reader! I miss him. I will not forget him.

A Word from John

I want to share excerpts from an article by Diana Davis that appeared in the latest edition of the Indiana Baptist Magazine. The title of the article is "Worship. Really." In her article, Davis states that when we attend church on Sunday our top priority must be to truly worship God. She shares 6 simple steps:

- 1. ANTICIPATE -Look forward to Sunday's worship service. Faithfully commit that time to God weekly. Pray for God to bless each person there and to speak to you personally.
- 2. ARRIVE EARLY -No exceptions! You have an important appointment with the King of Kings, so don't allow anything or anyone to make you even a split-second late.
- 3. ENGAGE -Engage in the worship service. True worship is not routine. It may help to sit near the front.
- 4. PARTICIPATE -Stand when it's time to stand. Sing every word of every song with joy and enthusiasm, directly to God. Listen to every word that's spoken. Listen expectantly to every word of the sermon.
- 5. EXPECT -Eagerly anticipate life-changing decisions during the invitation time. Don't even think about gathering your belongings or slipping out early. Your pot roast must not distract your worship of God.
- 6. LEAVE SLOWLY -Leave slowly and joyfully. Linger a moment. Keep your mind on God. Smile at a child. Meet a guest. Encourage a fellow believer.
