# A Word from Nick

Who is the wisest person that you know? Maybe it's your parents, your grandparents, or some person who seems to know how to traverse the difficulties of life especially well. However, in order to accurately answer this question we must take one more step back see how the Bible defines wisdom.

Wisdom is not just about knowledge. It's not just about possessing a lot of life experience either. Instead, it is knowledge that properly and effectively applies truth to everyday life. In James 3:13-18, James outlines for his audience what wisdom from both the world and God the Father look like. The Jews James was writing to would have understood that wisdom was not purely intellectual, but it was very practical as well. Thus the biggest fool was one who knew truth and failed to apply it. To the Jews, wisdom meant *skill in living righteously*.

So knowing that wisdom is also accompanied by action, does this change your initial answer to our question? James compares these two sources of wisdom to also parallel his previous discussion about faith and works in chapter 2:14-26. Just as a person's genuine faith will result in works, so also will a person who claims to be wise produce a righteous and holy life. Here is a comparison between the two types of wisdom from this passage:

<u>Worldly wisdom</u> – comes from hell, is motivated by self-centered ambition, and results in disorder and evil.

<u>Godly wisdom</u> – comes from heaven, is motivated by God-centered humility, and results in peace and righteousness

After knowing this, to what degree does the world's wisdom have an effect on the way you live your life? Examine your heart and "if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." (James 1:5)
