God answers prayer. "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:17). Elijah was not a super-pray-er. He was a man "Subject to like passions as we." The power was not in him, but in God. I don't know about you, but that encourages me to pray.

Here are some things to pray about. We focused on these in our service last Sunday night. You may want to keep this list handy and pray for these things for our church in your private prayer time. Pray through the list, reflecting on the scripture passages. Take one a day, if that works for you.

"Will you not revive us again?" (Ps. 86:5)

Pray for our church leadership to seek God with their whole hearts (Acts 6:4)

Pray for a spirit of repentance to fall on individuals and the congregation at large (Acts 5:11)

Pray for a spirit of humility to replace any pride that has arisen (Galatians 5:22-25)

Pray for Kingdom purposes to be accomplished within your life and through the congregation (Matthew 6:33)

Pray for a natural turning back to Jesus as the head of the church in all decisions (Ephesians 4:15-16)

Pray for a spirit of surrender to our Father's will following the example of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ (Luke 22:42)
