Pastor's Paragraphs

Last Sunday I spent a few minutes presenting the results of and giving an update on the TCAT survey process. Our leaders and workers have been working behind the scenes, seeking to use this process to advance the work here for the cause of Christ. We thought it would be a good idea to share with the church family as a whole about what is going on. Sixty-seven people took the TCAT survey (Thank you, by the way! Thank you!). The survey is a tool which measured our church according to seven characteristics of "transformational churches." It helped us to determine our strengths as well as to identify the areas we need to work on. After the survey, about 26 church leaders participated in a "Discovery Retreat" in which we developed seven "action points" we felt we needed to pursue. Then, our Leadership Team prioritized these action points into the top three. (I know that sounds involved, but I wanted to lay it out so you could see the steps involved. We tried to involve as many people as possible for maximum input.)

Below are the three action priorities our Leadership Team is recommending we pursue. We'll be presenting these in more detail in the days ahead and working to fulfill them.

Action Priority #1: **Prayer Focus and Prayer Strategy** – the goal is to develop and implement a prayer strategy that seeks to engage the entire church family in regular prayer for the church family itself, for the ministries of the church, and for the community.

Priority #2: Leadership Development - Goal: Develop and implement a training plan that equips leaders in spiritual growth and in ministry competencies and also provides training opportunities for potential leaders.

Priority #3: **Family Ministry** - Goal: Provide for family members in the church and community training and resources that will enhance Christian growth and discipleship in the home.

Let's pray and work, always keeping before us our great commission from the Lord of our church, to go and make disciples.
