Our Summer Community Groups have come to a close as we resume our Sunday night worship services. We still, however, seek to encourage one another in the faith. Hearing the testimonies last Sunday night from people whose lives were blessed through the community groups was a great blessing and encouragement to all of us. We also focused on some practical ways to fulfill the principle described in Prov. 27:17: "As iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend." Through our Christian fellowship we can truly sharpen each other spiritually. Here are some of the practical ways to do this that we discussed.

One is simply, know the Lord. How can you lead someone else to Christ or to a closer walk with Christ if you, yourself, do not know the Lord? Second is know the word. Paul told Timothy to seek the Lord "with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart," (2 Tim. 2:22)
